

Rules and Conditions of Entry

Hard hats pas 015 or en1384 kite marked in each case with a cover must be worn for all classes. **All hats must be brought to the secretary for checking when collecting your number.**

A beta standard level 3 back protector must be worn by all competitors on the cross country phase in classes 2,3 & 5 (area qualifiers). We strongly recommend that all competitors wear a level 3 body protector but a level 1,2 or 3 or one offering similar protection can be worn in classes 1 and 4.

MEDICAL ARMBANDS MUST BE WORN FOR BOTH SHOWJUMPING AND X-COUNTRY PHASES.

Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the Organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the Organisers of any events to which these rules apply nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accept any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories or any other person or property whatsoever whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.

The Chief Steward's decision is final.

ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEADS AT ALL TIMES

Competitors **MUST** give way to faster horses

No refunds given after close of entries unless a vets certificate or medical certificate is produced. Should the event be cancelled a 50% admin fee will be retained

This event will run under Riding Club rules

ODE course may be walked from 2pm until 5pm on Saturday 10th May – Gates will be locked after 5pm. Competitors are responsible for checking any alterations to the course plan on the day of the competition

Horses may NOT continue if eliminated and **MUST** leave the course at walk. Any person who has a fall anywhere on the competition site must be passed fit to ride by a paramedic before competing in the next stage or on another horse. Competitors eliminated in the show jumping may only start the x-country at the discretion of the steward.

Stopwatches are NOT permitted

£5 cash deposit for numbers is required on the day of the competition, no numbers will be given without the deposit

Any objections should be made to the secretary within 30mins of the incident and must be accompanied by a £10 deposit which will be refundable is the objection is upheld.
