**RULES & CONDITIONS OF CAMP**

1. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that Mortimer Riding Club, persons acting on their behalf, or their agents, or the landowners shall not be held responsible for any loss, injury, accident, damage or illness to horses, owners, riders or spectators or any other person whatsoever whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever. The committee recommend that all riders have adequate personal, Third-Party Liability and horse insurance.
2. Everyone mounted, whether a participant or not MUST wear protective headgear that includes a permanently fitted, non-detachable retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Such headgear must be worn with the harness properly adjusted and always fastened. A riding hat complying with BSEN1384 or EN1384 with PAS015 (1998 or 2011) or kite mark - but not BSEN1384 on its own, is the compulsory minimum required. Please see [www.bhs.org.uk](http://www.bhs.org.uk) for safety and for current requirements.
3. It is a requirement that a body protector to the latest standards are to be worn by all who are jumping and that medical arm bands are worn.
4. No refund of booking fees will be made except on receipt of a doctor's or veterinary surgeon's certificate or if your place can be filled.
5. No horse or pony under 4 years of age may be ridden at the event.
6. No dogs or stallions.
7. Please observe care in the parking area and follow instructions. Please leave the area tidy when you leave. No skipping out please.
8. First aid will be by 999/112 calls only. People attend at their own risk.
