#### **RULES & CONDITIONS OF CLINIC**

- 1. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that Mortimer Riding Club, persons acting on their behalf, or their agents, or the landowners shall not be held responsible for any loss, injury, accident, damage or illness to horses, owners, riders or spectators or any other person whatsoever whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever. All riders shall have adequate personal, Third Party Liability and horse insurance.
- 2. Everyone mounted, whether a competitor or not MUST wear protective headgear that includes a permanently fitted, non-detachable retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Such headgear must be worn with the harness properly adjusted and fastened at all times. A riding hat complying with BSEN1384 or EN1384 or kite mark but not BSEN1384 on its own, PAS015 2011 & SNELL 2016, as the compulsory minimum required. Please see www.bhs.org.uk for safety and for current requirements. MRC recommends that a body protector meeting the latest standards be worn in jumping events and that medical armbands are worn
- 3. No refund of entry fees will be made except on receipt of a doctor's or veterinary surgeon's certificate.
- 4. No horse or pony under 4 years of age may be ridden at the event.
- 5. No dogs or stallions.
- 6. It is recommended that you have details of your vet to hand at the event.
- 7. Please observe care in the parking area and follow instructions. Please leave the area tidy when you leave. No skipping out.
- 8. First aid will be by 999 calls only.
